Functions and Responsibilities

- Give wide and extensive publicity against ragging within and outside the campus
- Monitor and oversee the functioning of the Anti-Ragging Squad
- Ensure collection and verification of **Anti-Ragging Affidavits/Undertakings** from students and parents/guardians
- Conduct counselling and awareness sessions for senior students and freshers at the time of admission and induction
- Review and implement all directions issued by **UGC, AICTE, Government of Maharashtra, and University of Mumbai**

Compliance with University of Mumbai Circular

The Institute has received **University of Mumbai Circular No. SW/17/of 2021 dated 10/11/2021**, directing all affiliated institutions to implement multiple mechanisms to ensure a ragging-free campus. A copy of the said circular is attached herewith.

In compliance with the above:

- **Mr. Vinit Murli** is nominated as the **Nodal Officer** to coordinate with the University of Mumbai and UGC authorities
- The Nodal Officer shall access the anti-ragging portal through links forwarded by UGC/University to verify student submissions of online affidavits
- All directions issued vide the University circular dated **10/11/2021** shall be complied with **scrupulously**

Undertakings and Awareness Measures

- Online anti-ragging undertakings from **all students (new and existing)** and their parents/guardians shall be submitted and verified by the Nodal Officer
- Hostel residents shall submit an additional undertaking, duly signed by students and parents, to the respective Hostel Wardens
- **UGC-developed films and documentary videos** on the ill effects of ragging shall be screened during the **Orientation Programme for AY 2025-26**

This order comes into force with immediate effect.
